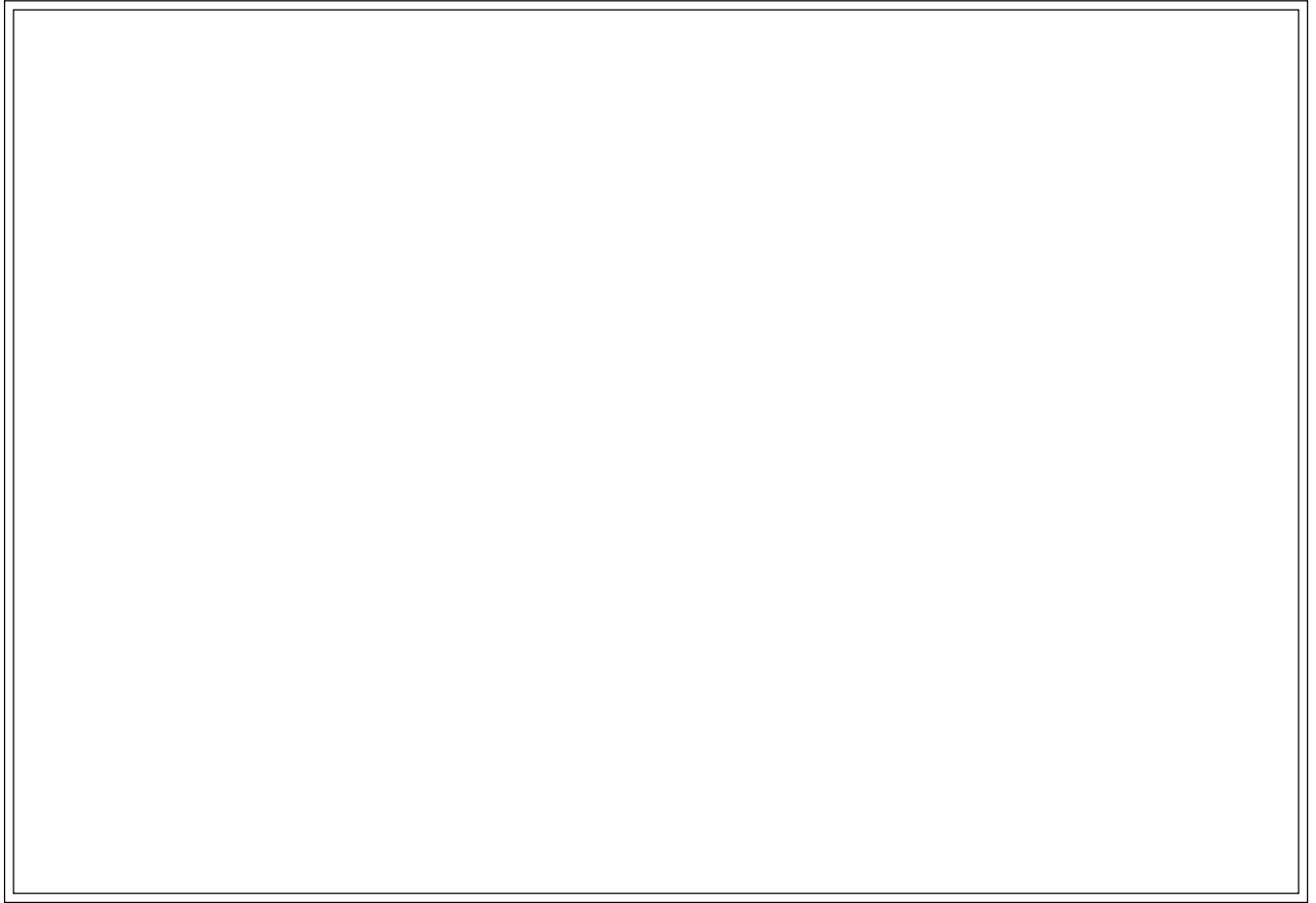
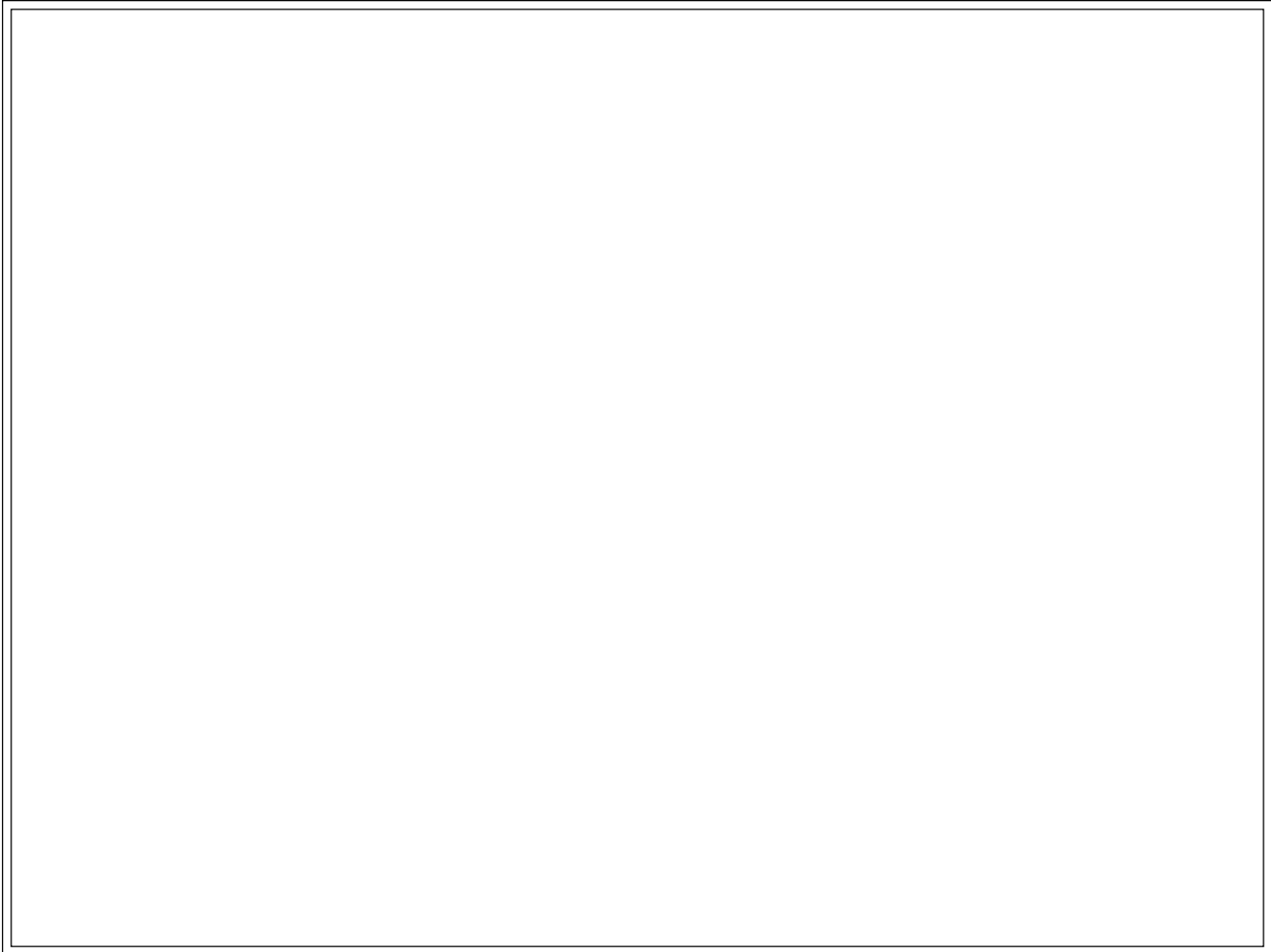


What Am I?
